Thank you for your application to renew your firearm / shotgun certificate number 14/A/[Redacted]

I am writing to advise you that it will not be possible to decide your application before your certificate expires.

As your application was made eight weeks or more before the expiry date of your certificate, your certificate will now continue in force for a further period of eight weeks after it is due to expire, as provided by section 28B of the Firearms Act 1968. This letter serves as confirmation that your firearm / shotgun certificate will now expire on 01/11/2022, unless your application is determined sooner.

The terms and conditions of your certificate are unchanged during this period, allowing your continued possession of the firearms / shotguns / ammunition specified on your certificate and permitting you to continue to purchase ammunition in accordance with your certificate. You are advised to keep this letter with your certificate.

Should your application for renewal be granted, any additional period of validity provided under section 28B of the Firearms Act 1968 will count towards the duration of the renewed certificate, so that the total period of your renewed firearm / shotgun certificate would be five years.
