## FIREARMS ACTS 1968 TO 1997

Please find enclosed your temporary permit. **The permit is valid for 6 months only.**

In accordance with condition 3 of your certificate, I would remind you of your responsibility to advise the Firearms & Explosives Licensing Unit of any permanent change of address.

- 1 If you sell, let on hire, lend or give away a firearm to another person in the United Kingdom including a registered firearms dealer, **YOU MUST**
  - (a) comply with any instructions contained in the firearm certificate produced to you by the transferee; and
  - (b) within seven days notify the transaction **in writing** to the Chief Officer of Police who issued your certificate.
- 2 The notification mentioned in 1 above must contain a description of the gun (make, serial number, calibre, etc) and should be sent by recorded delivery, first class registered post, by fax 01392 452973 or by e-mail to [firearms.licensing@devonandcornwall.pnn.police.uk](mailto:firearms.licensing@devonandcornwall.pnn.police.uk).
- 3 Whilst holding a temporary permit you are unable to purchase, borrow or have gifted to you any firearms.
